

Connecting Your Android Device to CCS Wireless

Since all Android devices are a little different, the screenshots used in this guide will probably not match your device (they were taken on a Pixel 2), but the steps should be similar.

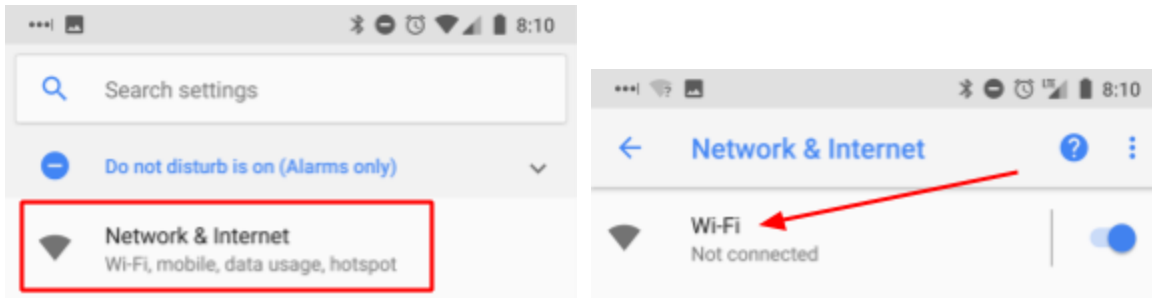

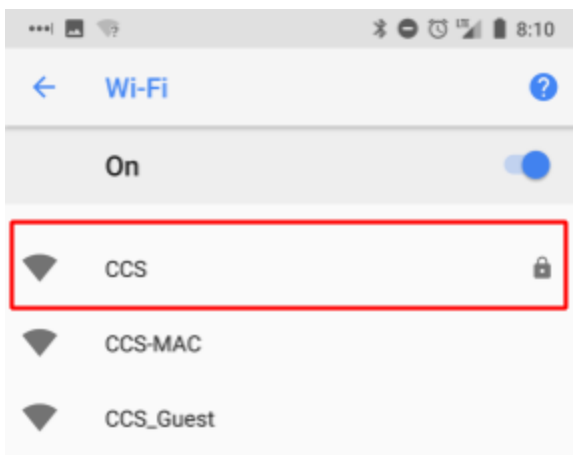
Open up Settings on your device



Find your network/internet/wireless/wi-fi settings



Make sure your wireless is turned on and select CCS (**not** CCS_Guest) from the list of available networks.

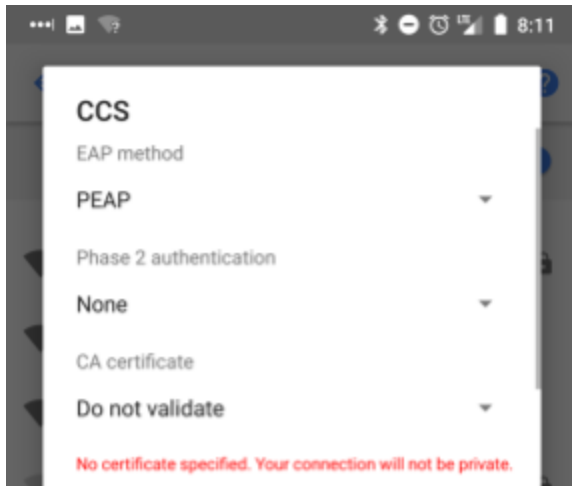


You may or may not need to adjust the settings so that your device connects correctly. If available, your settings should match those in the image below.

EAP Method = PEAP

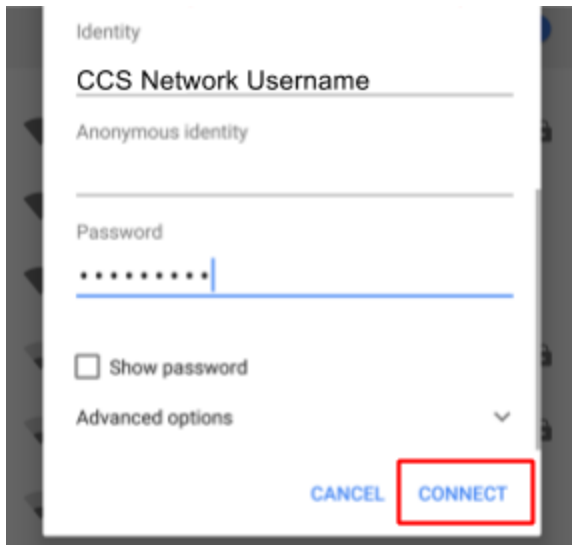
Phase 2 Authentication = None/Automatic

CA Certificate = Do not check/Do not validate (this may give you an error message - please ignore it)
You may also need to uncheck a box or setting for 'validating server certificate' or something similar.



Enter your CCS network username and password (you can leave the anonymous identity field blank)

Identity = CCS network Username
Password = CCS network Password
Anonymous Identity = leave blank



You should now be connected to the CCS Wireless
