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ORIENTATION DAYS:

Parents and students are invited to the classrooms on this day to visit with the EC staff, discuss each child's growth over the summer and address any transitional needs the students may have.

LATE START DAYS:

On late start days, AM classes will begin 40 minutes later than normal, at 8:20. AM classes will conclude at the regularly scheduled time. The length of the AM class has been adjusted to ensure there is no loss of instructional time. There will be no changes to the PM class schedule on these days. Students will not attend classes on Student/Family Support days.

STUDENT/FAMILY SUPPORT DAYS:

Early Childhood students do <u>not</u> attend class on the monthly Student/Family Support Days.

These days are essential for promoting and maintaining family participation in the student's educational program. Parent meetings or conferences and parent/family education events may be scheduled on these days. When appropriate, staff will have opportunity to monitor student progress in environments other than the Early Childhood classroom and collaborate with community providers (preschools, therapists, etc.) to develop and implement appropriate plans. Additionally, these days will be utilized for staff participation in ongoing professional development and activities designed to ensure fidelity of implementation of the curriculum.
