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#### Committee Reports

- Committee reports from attendees?
    - Fall Family Fun Night: Currently on track. Donations secured from Kroger. Event will feature: raffle, face painting, food, an inflatable obstacle course (adults run) and a borrowed gaga ball pit (adult run). Even will be in cafeteria if during inclement weather.
    - Popsicle Play Date: Second year this even was held. Event was a success.
    - Buddy Program - has been adjusted to a more informal “meet-up” style. Small group of new parents met at Carey Grove Park. Discussion of another informal event in January
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#### Principal's Report

- Theme for the year is “gearing up for greatness” which works hand-in-hand with the CCS theme of being “the best at getting better.”
- Continuum of initiatives this year, including: Responsive instruction, reading workshop, strategy groups, tech integration, MTSS, writing workshop, formative assessment, differentiation, math workshop, trauma sensitive best practices, stem, and conscious discipline.

- Tech integration - 1 to 1 ratio on chrome books in grades 2 to 5. Emphasis on technology only being used when amplifying learning, not to replace teaching.
- Conscious Discipline - Staff if on year 2 of a 3 year program of study on the book “Conscious Discipline” by Becky Bailey. Teachers attended summer training. Program focus on student safety, connection and problem solving.
  - Specials start times have been pushed back to allow for “connection time” between teachers/students first thing in the morning.
  - Monthly school wide “family meetings” have begun to increase sense of connection.
  - Focus for students on: an activity to unite, an activity to disengage stress, an activity to connect, and activity to commit oneself to positive thinking.
  - Additionally a quarterly goal will be presented. This quarter, the goal is to greet friends and adults with eye contact and a friendly hello or greeting.
  - School is currently working on a parent/family training night on the topic for cohesive school/home approach.
- Stem - New specials class, replacing computer lab. Mr. A pitched this to the district. Cherry Tree is piloting this for the district. Mr. Hegnauer moved from teaching 4th grade. He has a Masters Degree in scientific inquiry. Extremely positive feedback on this class so far. Additional stem integration through Mrs. Lima/media center.
  - No issues noted regarding lack of keyboarding class for kids as they performed NWEA testing.
- Reading Workshop - reading continues to be a priority. Classroom libraries are larger than ever. Reading time has been increased in classroom instruction.
