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SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

- Dr. Beresford congratulated Prairie Trace Elementary Teacher Sarah Awe for being named part of the 2019 class of Apple Distinguished Educators. Through a rigorous application process, she was recognized as an education pioneer that is using Apple technology to transform teaching and learning. She will be joining an exclusive team of 3000 educators from over 45 countries.
- Dr. Beresford congratulated Carmel High School Sophomore Graci Graves on being named the Leukemia & Lymphoma Society's Indianapolis Student of the Year. Graves earned the title by raising the most money, \$111,172, in a seven week period!
- Dr. Beresford congratulated the Carmel World Guard for being named silver medalists at the 2019 WGI Scholastic Worlds competition in Dayton, Ohio.
- Dr. Beresford shared with the Board that Carmel Clay Schools has been named the National Association of Music Merchants (NAMM) Best Communities for Music Education in the U.S for the 8th consecutive year. CCS is being recognized for demonstrating an unwavering commitment to providing comprehensive music education for all students. Carmel Clay Schools is one of only 4% of districts across the nation to receive this prestigious award. Dr. Beresford stated that he is proud of the district's fine arts staff, students, parents and community who continues to make music education a rich tradition of excellence at Carmel Clay Schools. He shared that he has been amazed by not only the quality of the students' performances, but also the joy they express in their practices, rehearsals and many steps along the way.
- Dr. Beresford reported that April 8-12 is National Library Week. He thanked all of our media specialists and media assistants who make a difference in the lives of our students by leading the way for them to develop a passion for learning and literacy. He mentioned that school libraries are no longer a place of quiet study but instead a place where students can collaborate, be creative, and engage in new technology to enhance the learning experience.
