#### <u>Treasurer's Report – Kim Berebitsky</u>

- We've begun spending money on carnival items and teachers have spent some enrichment money
- Kim gave the 1099 info to the accountant

- Big ticket item for carnival fundraising we don't have an idea for this yet. Tishia says Nikki talked to the teachers and there wasn't an overwhelming need. We could possibly use the money to support an outside organization or buddy with another school in the district. The TV studio update fell by the wayside because someone has to lead the charge and there aren't hands to do it.
- Kim talked to our bank, National Bank of Indianapolis, about options to replace pay2k for credit card purchases. The bank has a credit card reader and funds would go right into our NBI account. Cost is \$10 per month. They can also set up a website for parents to pay in advance. It costs \$150 to create and \$30 per month to maintain. Pay2K works fine for prior purchases but it's too complicated the night of. Kim will buy five readers and we can test them at Bingo night. If someone doesn't have a reader, the information can also be entered into the app. We have asked the district in the past about the bad wifi and nothing has changed.

- Important Dates

  - May 15<sup>th</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup> is kindergarten screening. Volunteers are needed. The pop up spirit wear has been a hit so we'll sell on screening days
  - Final executive board and general board meeting for the year is May 16<sup>th</sup>.
- Carnival
  - Carnival is March 8<sup>th</sup> and we need all hands on deck.
  - We have a new sweet shop chair, Marcia Jay.
  - The silent auction committee is decreasing the number of items. We're removing items that only receive 1 or 2 bids or made less than \$80 in prior years.

# Vice President's Report – Shaune Shelby

- Coordinating Council Meeting
  - The group heard from DECA about redoing the vision statement for Carmel. The statement needs to be inclusive and represent who we are today.
  - Everyone is still getting used to the website update. It's a live site so how do we archive older things, such as Friday flyers.
  - We have a new Safety Director and he gave a presentation about the new Stop It app. The messages go to the school principals and SRO's, Dr. Beresford and the Security Director.
  - A video was shown to demonstrate how to handle a security situation and the video was perceived as racially insensitive and offensive. Dr. Beresford says it will no longer be shown.
- Friends of Coyotes
