CHARGING POLICY

At the elementary level, a student may charge the equivalent of three days (breakfast & lunch). Charges are not permitted beyond a negative balance of \$12.00 or a negative balance of \$1.20 for reduced-price eligible students. Middle School students may charge up to 2 days (\$8.00) and one charge day (\$4.00) is permitted for High School students. It is the parent's responsibility to see that their child has a home packed lunch, cash/check or money in their account. Students will be charged for a Courtesy Meal until their balance is paid.
