## Corresponding Secretary Report - Lauren Edmundson

## President's Report - Tishia Smith

- Carnival
- Carnival preparations are moving along. We now have volunteer co-chairs to get people in place
- Carmel Police Department will be there to provide security
- Prizes and lanyards have been ordered
- The PayK12 site has been updated so we can use credit cards. We've secured six swipers but the swiper has to be paired with a newer ipad that can handle the app.
- Marcia says the Sweet Shop is going well. She asked for a budget to do some fun decorating; we usually don't have one but Tishia asked for specifics of what she wants to do
- Café and food are great and new this year will be snow cones. A TME parent has a professional snow cone maker. We just need to order the ice.
- Mrs. Raasch checked with technology and there will be open access to wifi with no password needed
- Volunteering
- We continue to need volunteers for school events and clubs and need to generate ideas of how to pull families back into PTO. Shaune suggests we have a PTO informational meeting to show parents their options for helping out.
- The chess and math club do not have enough parent volunteers. Parents of the kids in the clubs are supposed to rotate helping out but it is not enforced.
- If we don't have the hands from parents, we may need to look at cutting the clubs
- PTO is in need of supplies such as ipads and a wireless printer. We need to add a line item for supplies at the April budget meeting


## Vice President's Report - Shaune Shelby

- Carnival
- We are going to be making the transition from the Carnival to an adult only evening silent auction with a theme (such as 70's night).
- The drive for the transition is that the auction is really where the money is made and we have less and less Carnival volunteers, with all the work falling on the board members
- A lot of the other Carmel schools use the Ritz Carlton; Shaune talked to Bar Louie about hosting
- The plan would be to do a separate event for the kids, but not on the same night as the adult event
- We need to do our due diligence on how to plan this transition - what has worked for other schools. We also don't want to conflict with the dates other schools choose


## Principal's Report - Nikki Raasch

- May $16^{\text {th }}$ and $17^{\text {th }}$ is kindergarten screening
- Erin Buesink, the school psychologist, is at TME 2.5 days a week and needs a more private space. The PTO is using some of the space in her office. Nikki looked for alternatives and there are two huge closets in the LGI room. She's going to have the closets cleaned out after carnival to be used as PTO space.
